WIND POWER PROJECT

What is KEPA planning to build?

- A wind project to generate 101.2 megawatts (MW) of renewable power
- Enough electricity to power approximately 30,000 Ontario households
- 44 wind turbines
- Ancillary facilities including an operation and maintenance building, access roads, land-based electrical lines, junction sub-station, and a transformer sub-station
- A facility that helps Ontario achieve its target of 10% of its power production from renewable resources by 2010
